Exit was a collaboration between Paul Trevor, Chris Steele-Perkins and Nicholas Battye founded in 1973. Following a first project close to the Half Moon which led to a booklet *Down Wapping* they were approached by the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation to extend their work to inner cities throughout the UK. Over the next six years they produced some 30,000 pictures and 100 hours of taped interviews, a selection of which were published as *Survival Programmes: In Britain's Inner Cities, Exit Photography Group* (The Open University Press) 1982

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
